

10 hurt in Tripura campaign clash



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AGARTALA: More than [ten](#) people sustained injury when two [group](#) of political activists clashed with each other in [Tripura](#) on Wednesday.

The clash took place in Matabari area in the afternoon when two parties took out a simultaneous procession in support of their local poll candidate.

All of a sudden, a section of the processionists turned violent and had an altercation provoking each other. Then the mild tussle broke into a clash where at least 15 people from both the groups sustained injury.

The seriously injured processionists have been undergoing treatment in the hospital.

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
