

10 yr rigorous imprisonment for rapist

TINSUKIA: A local court in [Tinsukia](#) has ordered [ten](#) years rigorous imprisonment of a tea garden worker four years after he raped a girl of his locality.

Judge PJ Saikia, further has imposed Rs 10,000 as [compensation](#) to the victim failing which he would have spend six more months in the jail.

Identified a [Krishna](#) Karmakar, the tea garden worker in Silikha Tea Estate was arrested on the rape charge in 2013. The police chargesheeted him in 2015.

The court convicted him and ordered RI for [ten](#) years much to the satisfaction of many local organizations and individuals who lauded the prompt action of the police men who were probing the incident.

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
