

100 injured as Guwahati-Puri Express derails in blast



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At least 120 people have been injured when Adivasi Peoples' Army triggered a powerful blast on the railway tracks in Rangiya that derailed four bogies of the Guwahati-Puri Express on Sunday. The incident took place in between Rangiya and Ghagraapar at around 8 in the evening. A deafening sound rocked the entire area just before the derailment where over 100 passengers have been injured. They have been rushed to the Rangiya hospital. A large crater was created on the tracks because of the the impact of the remote-controlled blast.
