

10th Asia Pacific Tchoukball Championship Concludes in Hong Kong



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KOKRAJHAR, JULY 28: The 10th edition of the Asia Pacific Tchoukball Championship, 2024, concluded on Sunday with a three-day event held in Hong Kong, China.
