

## 14 militants surrender in Diphu

Fourteen militants belonging to three separate outfits, on [Wednesday](#) surrendered before [Diphu police](#) on [Wednesday](#). They further deposited a huge cache of [arms](#) and ammunition before [Karbi](#) Anglong Superintendent of Police M J Mahanta. These include seven from United Peoples' Liberation Front ([UPLF](#)), four from [Karbi](#) National Liberation [Army](#) (KNLA) and three of the [Karbi](#) Peoples' Liberation Tigers (KPLT). The surrendered [UPLF](#) militants have been identified as Naisring Parbosa, Anep Langthasa, Tushi [Bodo](#), [Manik](#) Haflongbar, Suhit Nabensa, Rohito Kemprai and Bidyut Langthasa and they deposited a M21 Chinesemade rifle, a SBBL gun, a Germany-made 9 MM pistol and two Chinese hand grenades. The KNLA militants have been identified as Songja Tokbi, Kensing Ronghang, Arun Engti and Kamsing Rongpi and they deposited a AK-47 rifle, two magazines of AK-47 rifle, a broken magazine of AK-47 rifle, 29 rounds of ammunition, a 9 mm pistol, seven rounds of 9 mm ammunition, 13 live rounds of 7.62 mm ammunition and six live rounds of 12 bore cartridge. The surrendered militants from KPLT include Probhat Singnar, Rajib Singnar and Francis Terang and they deposited a Chinese hand grenade.

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
