

3 killed in elephant attack



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Three persons of a family were trampled to death by wild elephants in Nagaon district on Sunday.

The incident took place in the wee hours in Satmukhi village where a herd of wild elephants barged into a hut in search of food.

As the family members tried to escape, they were trampled to death while another managed to flee from the spot.

The deceased were identified as Mois Munda, Sanjoy Munda and Ansu Munda while Saraswati Munda managed to survive.

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
