

4 truckers kidnapped in Bokajan



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Security forces are fanning in Bokajan area in Karbi Anglong district in search of 4 truckers 24 hours after they were kidnapped at gunpoint.

Top ranked police officials have been camping in Bojajan to monitor the rescue operation.

Police have picked up three local youths in this connection.

Interrogation is going on.

But sources have denied any role of militant outfits in the case where four Imphal bound truckers were taken away by a group of 4 miscreants from a petrol pump on Thursday wee hours.

The incident took place in the wee hours where four armed youths who came on a vehicle took away the truckers when they were waiting at a petrol pump in Bokajan.

Then they were taken away towards Dimapur.

The incident came to light only in the evening on Thursday.

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
