

5 dead in Silchar landslide



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Five persons of a family were buried alive when a huge hillock collapsed on their house in Cachar district on Wednesday.

The incident took place in the wee hours at Lakhipur where when a huge hillock slipped into the house where Zubeda Khatun along with her four children lived in.

“It came to light at around [10](#) in the morning as the local residents had to keep themselves confined to their homes because of the incessant rains,” a local resident told Assam Times [over](#) telephone.

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
