

5 votes for Hussian cancelled



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Cancellation of five crucial votes stymied the poll prospect of Opposition candidate Haidor Hussain. These mistakes, mostly, are allegedly intentional.

BJP legislator Prasanta Phukan's vote stood cancelled the moments after he displayed his ballot paper to all the party agents and observers after casting his vote. BJP sources called it unintentional.

AIUDF MLA Gopinath Das signed the ballot paper forcing the authorities to cancel it at the eleventh hour.
