

550 villages under flood



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Assam State Disaster Management Authority ([ASDMA](#)) said 1,95,243 people have been affected as flood waters submerged 533 villages.

The government has opened toll free phone numbers -- 1070 for the State Emergency Operation Centre, and 1077 for the District Emergency Operation Centre.

Talking to Assam Times, official sources said the flood waters have also affected [over 8,245](#) hectares of [crop](#) land.

The government asked the district administrations to arrange relief and rescue material, and take stock of the infrastructural damage.

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
