

## 85 nominations in Kokrajhar

As many 85 candidates from various parties and independent including BPF, Bjp, [Congress](#), Aiudf filed their nomination papers for 12 constituencies under three subdivisions Kokrajhar, [Gossaigaon](#) and Parbatjhora to contest scheduled April 8 election.
