Anowar Hussain, president of Kokrajhar district [AAMSU](#) said the budget placed for the [2016](#)-17 was not acceptable for the a section of [community](#) in the stste, specially minority [community](#) have been deprived from this plan.

'There was nothing special schemes or plan have included for minority [community](#) in the budget. It was unfortunate for the [community](#) that [state](#) budget has been declining to provide development [welfare](#) fund in the [state](#)', he said adding that government should withdraw it's budget plan so that equal development and distribution could be availed in the [state](#).
