

ABVP leader dead in GMCH



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The youth who sustained injury in the Paltanbazar [city](#) bus accident died on GMCH.

GMCH sources told Assam Times that he died on Saturday afternoon 24 hours after the [ABVP leader](#) was rushed to it.

Notably, a [Khanapara](#) bound [city](#) bus rammed into his two wheeler after the driver lost his control [over](#) the bus on Friday.

Since then he was battling for life at the ICU at GMCH.
