

Administration monitoring flood situation in Kokrajhar



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District administration, Kokrajhar has been monitoring flood situation in Kokrajhar which has been creating resented among citizens in the district since few days back following incessant raining in the region. [Madhav](#) Prasad Sarma, Kokrajhar DC and district magistrate told this correspondent that district administration has been monitoring flood situation with fully prepared of flood [rescued](#). He said that district administration has also convened all line departmental official to discuss about flood related matters to create awareness on flood [rescued](#) management [as](#) well protection of the floods.
