

AGP's failure in upper Assam

In the last assembly election, the Asom Gana Parishad was unable to get a single seat in upper Assam along with other 12 districts of Assam. Under Golaghat district - Sarupather, Bokakhat, Khumtai and Golaghat LACs are captured by the INC. It is mentioned that the Golaghat is the birth place of AGP. In Jorhat district all 6 LACs are owned by the Congress. In Sivasagar all 6 LACs, in Dibrugarh 6 out of total 7 LACs and in Tinsukia district 4 out of 5 LACs were gone to the Congress Party. In entire Upper Assam only Dibrugarh and Dumduma LAC are owned by the opposition BJP. AGP lost in Sarupather, Khumtai, Dergaon, Amguri, Tingkhang, which were in their hand after the Assembly election of 2006. In entire upper Assam AGP failed to show its existence in any constituency.
