

AGP-BJP alliance retains Nagaon, Congress wins Kaliabor

BJP-AGP supported candidate for Nagaon Lok Sabha seat Rajen Gohain retained the prestigious Nagaon seat defeating his nearest political rival Anil Raja of Congress by more than 45,000 votes. Rajen Gohain secured 3,80,118 while Anil Raja secured 3,34,818 votes. This is for the third time Gohain has won the Nagaon LS seat. On the other hand AUDF candidate Sirajuddin Ajmal secured 2,05,591 votes.

It is worth mentioning that BJP took lead in Nagaon, Raha, Jagiroad, Barhampur, Hojai, and Lumding while Congress party in Morigaon, Laharighat and AUDF in Jamunamukh LAC's. A total of 9,99,180 votes were polled out of 14,17,609.

Again Dip Gogoi, brother of the Chief Minister Tarun Gogoi, of Congress retained the Kaliabor HPC by defeating his nearest rival Gunin Hajarika of BJP-AGP alliance by over 1,50,442 votes. Dip Gogoi secured 4,32,257 votes while Gunin Hajarika secured 2,81,815 votes. Again AUDF candidate Sirajuddin Ajmal secured 1,90,375 votes. Here Congress took lead in Batadrava, Samaguri, Bokakhat, khumtai, Sarupathar, Golaghat and Dergaon LAC's while AGP took lead in Kaliabor and AUDF in Dhing and Rupohihat. A total of 9,29,735 votes were polled out of 13,46,255.
