

AGP leader Prabin Gogoi dead

Pall of [gloom](#) descends in Golaghat district when senior AGP [leader](#) Probin Gogoi died after prolonged illness in Guwahati on Monday. The end came for the founder AGP [leader](#) at 10-30 in the morning at the Guwahati Medical College Hospital where he was undergoing treatment. He was 66.

Gogoi, the [leader](#) in the Assam agitation was elected to the Assam assembly for the first time from AGP in 1985. He was sports, civil supply minister in the Mahanta cabinet in its first term. In 1996, he was elected again [as](#) independent. Again he won with AGP ticket in 2002 and 2006.

Local residents in Khomtai thronged his residence at Chandannagar area [as soon as](#) the sad news spread like wildfire. Party [leaders](#) and activists deeply condoled his death and conveyed deep sympathy to his bereaved family members.
