

AGP still opposed to citizenship amendment



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The Asom Gana Parishad, a vital constituent of the BJP-led government in Assam has reiterated it's opposition to the Citizenship (Amendment) Bill, 2016.

The regional party made its position clear when a delegation met Union home minister Rajnath Singh in [New Delhi](#) on Wednesday. Led by party president Atul Bora, the delegation told Singh not to proceed with this [deal](#).

The party [leaders](#) stressed immediate implementation of the Assam Accord, 1985 in letter and spirit by detecting and deporting the Bangladeshi immigrants who came to settle in the [state](#) after the cut off date.

The delegation met [President](#) of [India](#) reiterating the [demands](#) amid speculation of a widening differences with BJP [over](#) the controversial bill which if made an Act will enable the Hindu illegal settlers to get a refugee status across the country.

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NAZIRA, September 27, 2026 — Tension continues to prevail in Nazira, particularly in the Santak-Bihubar area, following the killing of Biman Barua, president of the Rangajan Yuva Samaj and a youth social worker, on September 18 under Bihubar Police Station.

Following the killing, local residents have been demanding stringent punishment for the alleged masterminds, Ravindra Singh alias Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan, besides seeking demolition of Vicky Singh's residence.

Meanwhile, Sivasagar district police have taken Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan into custody and are questioning them at the district headquarters police station in connection with the murder case and allegations of drug-related activities.

According to police sources, the two allegedly told investigators during questioning that drugs were brought from Dimapur and Nagaland and stored at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister in Nazira town. The drugs were allegedly supplied from the house to users in different parts of Nazira and Sivasagar.

Based on the information allegedly obtained during the questioning, a joint team of Bihubar Police and Nazira Model Police Station conducted a raid at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister, Rinki Singh Bora, in Ward No. 6 of Nazira town on Saturday morning.

Police detained Rinki Singh Bora and are reportedly questioning her in connection with the alleged storage and distribution of drugs.

The investigation into the murder of Biman Barua and the alleged drug network is continuing.
