

AGP top guns meets to discuss unification issue



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The main Opposition Asom Gana Parishad is holding a crucial meeting in the city of Guwahati on Tuesday to clear the road for unification of the regional forces. According to information the executive meeting will discuss in detail the report being tabled by the party's unification panel headed by working president Phani Bhushan Chaudhory.
