

Air ambulance in Manipur soon



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The Ministry of [Development](#) of North Eastern Region (DoNER) has sanctioned Rs 25 crore to introduce air ambulance service in remote locations of [Manipur](#), [Governor](#) Dr Najma Heptulla has said.

Interacting with media persons at the Raj Bhavan here on Wednesday, the [Manipur Governor](#) Dr Najma said the amount was sanctioned by the DoNER Ministry after she personally moved the proposal in a recent meeting of the North Eastern Council (NEC).

“Discussions are on to decide the proposed air medical service delivery model in the [state](#),” the [Governor](#) said.

She hoped the usefulness of the service of flying doctors would be able to reach and help people in remote locations of the [state](#).

On the other hand, Dr Najma also called on the people to join the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, the most significant cleanliness campaign by the Government of [India](#).
