

AJYCP continues protest over oilfield auction



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The simmering protest [over](#) the move to auction 12 marginal oil fields in Assam refuses to die down when [AJYCP](#) blocked many oilfields in Sivasagar district disrupting the [normal](#) functionings on Wednesday. [AJYCP](#) activists in large number simultaneously blocked these oilfields in protest [against](#) the controversial move by the [Narendra Modi](#) Government.

With banners and festoons, [AJYCP leaders](#) and [workers](#) staged demonstration in a number of oilfields opposing the auction move forcing the halt of [normal](#) functionings for several hours. They further shouted slogans asking Delhi and Dispur not to go ahead.

“We are quite unhappy. The [Narendra Modi](#) Government at the Centre has downplayed the sentiments of the entire people of Assam,” said a protestor.

Another [AJYCP leader](#) who participated in the blockade said, “we do warn the government not to proceed with the [deal](#). Otherwise, we are bound to take some hard decisions.”

The organization has been opposing the move for the last couple of weeks in the form of road blockade, rail rook where the activists have already burnt the [effigies](#) of Prime Minister [Narendra Modi](#) , [petroleum](#) minister Dharmendra Pradhan and Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal.
