

AJYCP threatens massive stir



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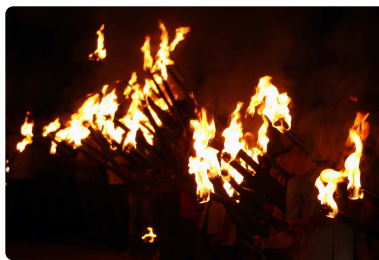


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Hours after BJP topguns in Guwahati endorsed the move to auction 12 oilfields and to welcome the foreign Hindu [refugees](#), [AJYCP](#) threatens to launch a massive agitation to force the government to undo it. Talking to Assam Times [over](#) telephone, [AJYCP](#) president Biraj Talukdar said, “Assam is not the property of a section BJP [leaders](#). Nobody has given these politicians the right to do whatever they want.”
