

Akhil free to move court for bail



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A [state level](#) advisory panel in Assam cleared the decks on Sunday for Akhil Gogoi to move the court for bail. Gogoi, who was arrested under the [National](#) Security Act is moving a bail [petition](#) before the Gauhati High Court in a day or two.

The advisory panel listened to the case pertaining to the arrest of the KMSS [leader](#) and will take up it again on October 26.

Gogoi was arrested under NSA last month a couple of weeks after he was lodged in Dibrugarh Central Jail for openly urging the common people to remain prepared for an armed struggle.

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
