Dispur police arrested Akhil Gogoi in a fresh case on Saturday before the court of chief judicial magistrate in Kamrup had sent the KMSS president to the jail.

Gogoi was produced before the CJM court in the morning where he was remanded to judicial custody for yet another period of 14 days.

Gogoi has been languishing in jail from March 5 after five days in police custody in connection with the self immolation of a KMSS activist.

The Gauhati High Court on March 19 will hear his bail petition in three other cases.
