

Hundreds of activists from AKRSU and Koch Rajbongshi Mahila Samiti joint hands with banner, placards in the sit in demonstration in front of DC office on Tuesday in Kokrajhar, demanded creation of Kamatapur separate [state](#) and Scheduled Tribe status to the Koch Rajbongshis in earliest manner.

A three hour sit-in-demonstration was organized by AKRSU to put pressure government while solving the [demands](#) of the [community](#). The agitators shouted slogans demanding early solutions of issue and [demands](#) of the Koch Rajbongshi [community](#) to gain [community welfare](#) and development in the region.

A memorandum was submitted to Chief Minister through Deputy Commissioner, Kokrajhar seeking early solution of the issues and [demands](#) of the AKRSU.

Hiteswar Barman, president of the AKRSU participating the agitation demanded early creation of separate Kamatapur [state](#) and granting of [ST](#) status to the Rajbongshis in immediate matter through political talk.

He has warned to take vigorous movement if their [demands](#) are not in earliest manner.
