

All party meet to end NRC logjam



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GUWAHATI: All party legislators are hunkering down in Guwahati on Wednesday to break the logjam [over](#) NRC after the Centre sought the Supreme Court's permission to extend the date to publish the draft.

Assam assembly Speaker Hitendra Nath Goswami is presiding [over](#) the crucial meeting of the legislators to discuss the ongoing controversy where the various organizations and opposition parties have called it a calculated conspiracy to include the names of the Hindu Bangladeshi immigrants in the NRC draft.

The home [ministry](#) recently moved a [petition](#) before the country's apex court seeking an extension of the date to publish the NRC draft till July 31 next year triggering fresh controversy.

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
