

ANCC blocks National Highway



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[Adivasi National](#) Convention Committee blockades [National](#) Highway along Karigaon in Kokrajhar district today demanded [ST](#) status to the [Adivasi community](#), solve the militant issue and problems of the ceasefire groups of militant outfits of the Adivasis through political dialogue [as soon as](#) possible.

Hundreds of agitators with banner, placards blockade the national highway which have been affected road communication along the highways.
