

Another record in Assam: 40,885 saplings planted in 1 hour

Assam scripts yet another history on Sunday. Altogether 100 people on Sunday planted 40,885 saplings within an hour near the Chirang Reserve Forest to enter the Guinness World Records. Army's Dogra Regiment and 135 Ecological Battalion jawans planted the saplings on the banks of the Saralbhangra river on Sunday from 11 in the morning to 12 noon. The entire rare event was video-graphed in full view of three independent observers. The footage would now be sent to Guinness World Records.
