

APSC: Akhil moves HC with PIL



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Finally Akhil Gogoi moved the Gauhati High Court alleging rampant corruption in the Assam Civil Service examination .

The KMSS president who has been spearheading the [fight against](#) APSC has filed a public interest litigation seeking the court's intervention.
