

APSC Scam: Police quizzes Gautom Roy



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An Assam police team from Dibrugarh grilled Gautom [Roy](#) on Monday for a couple of hours in connection with the APSC scam where jobs were sold for money.

Led by SS Panesar, the police team in the Kahiliprar based SB office premises was believed to have extracted statement from the former minister on his alleged involvement in striking secret [deal](#) with a section of candidates because of his close association with chairman Rakesh [Paul](#), who is yet to come out of the jail.

[Roy](#) allegedly brokered the [deal](#) with a number of senior [Congress leaders](#) to ensured jobs for their candidates for lakhs of rupees. The senior political [leader](#) from [Barak](#) valley helped [Paul](#) get the top chair in the [state](#) public service commission.

Sources told Assam Times the probe into the APSC scam is likely to end very [soon](#) and the police team is preparing an additional chargesheet to be submitted before the court.

[Roy](#) was grilled by the vigilance team last month for his alleged involvement in the multi crore scam in the social [welfare](#) department.

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
