

Army boss gets tougher with NDFB-S



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Army Chief General Dalbir Singh Suhag on Saturday asked field commanders in Assam to firmly [deal](#) with NDFB-S militants who killed at least 75 people in Kokrajahr and Sonitpur districts on Tuesday.

General Suhag reviewed the deployment of army in the combing operation [against](#) the militant outfit and asked them to go all out [against](#) NDFB-S.

In a series of meeting with his field commanders, the army [boss](#) reviewed the current status of operations and various measures taken to improve the security scenario in the state. He further assured the authority of additional support to [deal](#) with the militants. He would closely monitor the operation.

General Suhag arrived in Tezpur in the morning and after holding a meeting, he undertook an aerial survey of the strife-torn areas. Then he left for [New Delhi](#).

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
