

Army boss on stock taking visit



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Army [chief](#) General Dalbir Singh Suhag is on a visit to Assam on Saturday to take stock of the crackdown [against](#) NDFB-S four days after the militant outfit killed at least 70 people in Kokrajhar and Sonitpur district.

General Suhag met Union home minister Rajnath Singh in [New Delhi](#) on Friday is arriving in Tezpur in the morning. Apart from holding high level meeting with top army officials to discuss the combing operation in the violence-hit districts, he is likely to meet [chief](#) minister Tarun Gogoi to review the situation later today.

Minutes after his meeting with Rajnath Singh, general Suhag gave hint of an intensified crackdown [against](#) the militant outfit who owed down at least 70 [Adivasi](#) people.

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
