Normalcy is yet to be restored along the [Assam](#)-Nagaland [border](#) in [Golaghat](#) district. Indefinite [curfew](#) is in [force](#) from 6 in the evening to 6 in the morning.

[Security forces](#) on Friday caught three arsonists red-handed when they allegedly tried to torch some abandoned houses in Chetiagaon.

Three additional [CRPF](#) companies have been fanning in the affected areas to thwart any attempt by the [miscreants](#) who have been unleashing terror these days.

According to sources, eight [new](#) pickets had been set up by the CPRF in vulnerable villages. A control room has is being jointly manned by [CRPF](#), [Assam](#) Police and Nagaland Police.

The [attack](#) by [armed](#) [miscreants](#) on eight villages in [Uriamghat](#) area left two [dead](#) and three [injured](#) while the [miscreants](#) torched around 200 houses.

Over 10,000 people, who fled their houses from eight affected villages, have taken shelter in 10 relief camps.
