

Assam CM discharged from Max hospital



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The Asian Heart Institute has discharged Assam chief minister Tarun Gogoi nearly a month after two critical open heart surgeries. Doctors at this Mumbai based hospital called his health fit and fine after a special check up. According to sources, the chief minister was discharged at 7 in the evening on Friday. Immediately after it, he shifted to Hotel Trident where he would spend 2 days before leaving for Delhi. Gogoi is scheduled to arrive in Guwahati on Wednesday.
