

Assam confirms its second H1N1 virus infection case



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Assam on Tuesday has confirms its second swine flu cases within a period of four days. The confirmation came from the Regional Medical Research Centre at Lahowal in Dibrugarh three days later an army jawans was admitted at the Basistha based hospital in Guwahati.

He is identified as Raj Kumar Sinha, an army jawan. Immediately after he was suspected to be a case of H1N1 virus infection, his sputum samples were sent to RMCH for test.

Notably, Assam confirmed its first case of the kind on Saturday when a 21 year old boy from Pune Dhiraj Yadav tested positive after he came to Guwahati. According to information, Dhiraj, who is undergoing treatment at the MMC Hospital in Guwahati is table.
