

Assam joins Republic Day celebrations



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GUWAHATI: Defying rebel diktat national tricolour is fluttering in the sky of Assam as the north eastern [state](#) joined the nation wide 69th Republic Day on Friday.

[Governor](#) Jagdish Mukhi is unfurling the tricolour and took salute of the army, police and para military forces at the [Khanapara](#) Veterinary Playground in the morning.

All cabinet [ministers](#) are hoisting the flag at their assigned district headquarters amid an elaborate security arrangement.
