

Assam tops crimes against women



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[Assam](#) is most unsafe for [women](#). The state tops the [list](#) of crimes against fair sex in the entire north eastern region.

According to the National Crime Records Bureau report the state remains in the seventh place in the all India level. [Assam](#) jumped to 17,449 cases of crimes against [women](#) in 2013 as against 13,544 in 2012.

[Assam](#) leads the [list](#) for all recorded crimes against [women](#), including [rape](#), kidnapping and abduction, dowry deaths and cruelty by husband and his relatives.

The state reported 1,937 incidents of [rape](#) in 2013 as against 1,716 in 2012 to be followed by Tripura, where 233 cases were registered as against 229 in 2012.

again [Assam](#) tops the [list](#) with 170 deaths reported over 140 the year 2012. Thus the state recorded the highest incidence of 8,636 cases of cruelty by husband and his relatives towards [women](#).

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
