

Assamese films for Dhaka fest



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Four awarded Assamese films – Agnisnan by Dr Bhabendra Nath Saikia, Hkhagoroloi Bohu Door by internationally acclaimed Jahnu Barua, Joimoti of Manju Borah, Aideu by Arup Manna and two documentaries Hastir Kanya by Prabin Hazarika, and Koihatir Dhulia by Hemanta Das – will be screened at the Dhaka International Film Festival beginning on Thursday.
