

Assamese people safe in Meghalaya

The Assamese people in Meghalaya are fully safe and secured. This was [more](#) or less of what the various student bodies said to clear the confusion of simmering tension. NESO chairman Samuel Jyrwa told reporters that there was no communal tension. He told reporters in [Shillong](#) on [Tuesday](#) that only a section media in [Assam](#) has been spreading the rumour that the people of [Assam](#) have been asked to [quit](#). “The rumours are a handiwork of a satellite news channels based in [Guwahati](#),” he said after holding a [meeting](#) with several other organisations from [Assam](#) and Meghalaya. He said that several migrant labourers at the construction sites of IIM and NIFT in New [Shillong](#) Township were sent to [Assam](#) after they failed to prove their identities and having no work permits. [Shillong](#) Socio Cultural [Assam Students’](#) Association (SSCASA) general secretary [Krishna](#) Kant Borah blamed trouble mongers for spreading rumours, creating panic among students. The Meghalaya government also said there was no danger to people from [Assam](#) residing in the neighbouring mountainous state and warned [miscreants](#) against spreading rumours about their safety.

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Nazira tension persists after youth leader's killing; police probe alleged drug network

NAZIRA, September 27, 2026 — Tension continues to prevail in Nazira, particularly in the Santak-Bihubar area, following the killing of Biman Barua, president of the Rangajan Yuva Samaj and a youth social worker, on September 18 under Bihubar Police Station.

Following the killing, local residents have been demanding stringent punishment for the alleged masterminds, Ravindra Singh alias Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan, besides seeking demolition of Vicky Singh's residence.

Meanwhile, Sivasagar district police have taken Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan into custody and are questioning them at the district headquarters police station in connection with the murder case and allegations of drug-related activities.

According to police sources, the two allegedly told investigators during questioning that drugs were brought from Dimapur and Nagaland and stored at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister in Nazira town. The drugs were allegedly supplied from the house to users in different parts of Nazira and Sivasagar.

Based on the information allegedly obtained during the questioning, a joint team of Bihubar Police and Nazira Model Police Station conducted a raid at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister, Rinki Singh Bora, in Ward No. 6 of Nazira town on Saturday morning.

Police detained Rinki Singh Bora and are reportedly questioning her in connection with the alleged storage and distribution of drugs.

The investigation into the murder of Biman Barua and the alleged drug network is continuing.
