

Assembly changes sitting time



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The ongoing Assam Assembly session is all set to [start](#) from 9-30 from Wednesday instead of 9 in the morning.

The proposal was unanimously passed on the floor after parliamentary affairs minister Chandra Mohan Patowary moved the proposal.

Speaker Ranjeet Kumar [Das](#) announced the slight change in the timings which will come into force from Wednesday.
