The All [Tribal](#) Students' Union [Manipur](#) demands President's Rule in [Manipur](#) alleging utter [failure](#) of the [state](#) administrative machinery to firmly [deal](#) with the prevailing law break down.

In a memorandum signed by ATSUM President Muan Tombing and general secretary Vareiyu Shatsang urged prime minister Narendra Modi to impose President's Rule in the restive north eastern [state](#).
