

Bajrang bandh total



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The Bajrang Dal sponsored 12 hour statewide Assam [bandh](#) evokes total response across the state from Friday morning. Our correspondents from the district headquarters informed that [bandh](#) supporters in large numbers have come to the streets in many places and blocked the movement to vehicles as soon as the [bandh](#) hour began.

Hundreds of [bandh](#) supporters in [Morigaon](#), North Kamrup, Rongiya and staged protest by burning tyres on the streets and shouted slogans to put Badaruddin Ajmal behind the bars for his alleged nexus with the jihadi elements in Bangladesh.

State BJP along with ABVP have supported the [bandh](#) call after a satellite private channel broke the story citing an intelligence report alleging that the AIUDF chief has been dispatching a section of youths from Dhubri to undergo jihadi [training](#) in Bangladesh.

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
