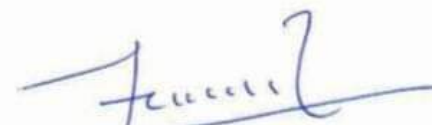
Hon'ble Congress President has appointed Shri Bhupen Bora as the President of Assam Pradesh Congress Committee with immediate effect.
