

Bir Chilagang Basumatary remembered



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Contributions of Bir Chilagang Basumatary, founder chairman of the now defunct Bodo Liberation Tiger (BLT) was remembered towards the Bodoland movement, who revolt with arms for the separate [state](#) of Bodoland within [India](#), on his 20th death [anniversary](#) at his burial place Bir Chilagang Puri, Bongshigaon on Wednesday in Kokrajhar district.

Irrespective of organization, party and local people thronged to paid floral tribute at the cemetery of Basumatary at Bongshigaon, was organized by Bir Chilagang Martyrs Tomb [Development](#) Committee, Bongshigaon.

Ramani Basumatary, widow of late Basumatary paid rich floral tribute to the tomb followed [leaders](#) from various organisations. Basumatary survived by wife, two sons and a daughter. Basumatary was the founder chairman of the then Bodoland Liberation Tiger (BLT) who revolt with arms for the separate [state](#) of Bodoland within [India](#), was born on 1st February, 1959 at Bongshigaon and expired on June 28, 1997 due to prolonged illness.
