

## BJP-led government in Dispur



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A BJP-led government is on the threshold in Dispur. BJP, AGP and BPF are set to form a coalition government in Assam in a day or two. The ruling party at the Centre has already announced Lakhimpur MP Sarbananda Sonowal [as](#) the [chief](#) ministerial candidate. The Union sports minister is taking a huge [lead](#) in Majuli while [Chief](#) Minister [Tarun Gogoi](#) is expected to retain his home seat [Titabor](#).

BJP alone is taking a comfortable [lead](#) in 48 seats while AGP is expected to get 17 seats and BPF will have to remain satisfied with [10](#) seats.

[Congress](#) camp is worried [over](#) the poor performance where [state](#) party president Anjan Dutta's daughter who contested in Amguri was defeated at the hands of his AGP rival Pradeep Hazarika. Several top [Congress](#) [leaders](#) have lost the polls paving the way for the BJP and its allies. AGP president Atul [Bora](#) won Bokakhat defeating his nearest rival [Congress](#) candidate Arun Phukan. AGP [leader](#) and former [chief](#) minister Prafulla kUmar Mahanta won in Barhampur while [Congress](#) candidate and minister Rockybul Hussain won Samoguri. The result would be officially confirmed by the evening.

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
