

BJP left embarrassed with Amit's speech

Mistakes after mistakes by [Amit Shah](#) in his speech in Dibrugarh rally left [state leaders](#) red faced on Friday. But who will tell the BJP president to be correct?

According to grapevine, Shah have worried all senior party [leaders](#) in the party a couple of months before the assembly polls.

"State president Sarbananda Sonowal himself was not satisfied with these utterings which would give Chief Minister [Tarun Gogoi](#) more ammunition to attack BJP in the electioneering heat and dust," said a senior BJP [leader](#) in Dibrugarh.
