

BJP seeks policy to regulate conversion



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The Assam BJP has demanded a specific set of policy from the Government on conversion saying it is mother of all social tension in the state. Addressing a press conference on Sunday in the city, state BJP president Ramen Dekha said conversion has been the main reason behind the simmering social tensions in Assam. Saying it inadmissible, Mr Dekha added that conversion is still going on in Assam adding that a clear cut policy should have to be there to regulate these. He further said infiltration has already disturbed the state's demography and it will be more harmful if conversion continues.
