

Bodos condole loss of leader

A pall of [gloom](#) descends in Kokrajhar and its adjoining BTAD districts when noted Bodo [leader](#) Someswar Brahma died after a massive cardiac [arrest](#) at hospital in Siliguri on Friday night. He was 70.

Hundreds of people rushed to his house at Baragari villages when the news of his demise spread like wild fire across the BTAD areas in the evening. The funeral is slated for Wednesday evening [as](#) more and more people are pouring in pay their last respect to the noted Boro personality.
