

Bodos remember Bineswar Brahma



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The Bodo [Sahitya Sabha](#) (BSS) remembered Subungthini Thandwi Bineswar Brahma, former president of Bodo [Sahitya Sabha](#), paying floral tribute at burial place o his 17th death anniversary in Kokrajhar on Saturday.

Brahma was shot dead by armed extremist at his Bhetapara residence in Guwahati on 19th August in 2000 when he was president of the Bodo [Sahitya Sabha](#). He was deputy general manager in [FCI](#) for northeast region.
