

Body found in Morigaon; Flood toll 44



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Flood waters continue its receding [trend](#). But the affected people have yet to get out of the blues. The toll has gone up to 44 with the recovery of yet another body in [Morigaon](#) on Thursday. With this, the toll in Goalpara alone stands at 20 while 16 persons lost their lives in Kamrup Rural. These are apart from 6 in Guwahati and one each in [Morigaon](#) and Dhubri. According to official information, 242 villages in four districts are still reeling under the flood waves. In Goalpara, nearly 3.7 lakh people are affected, followed by around 15,000 in Kamrup Rural district.

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
